Role play

1. The class is divided in 3 groups.
Group A, you are the group of the grandparents. Think about what older people talk about most often.
Group B, you are the group of the parents. What do parents talk about most often?
Group C, you are the group of the children. What do children in a family (siblings) talk about?
2. Make new small groups of three students having one representative from groups A, B and C. The task of each group is to play a dialogue in which all actors participate. Children might suggest to their grandparents to teach them something new, e.g. to show them a new application on their mobile and teach them how it works; teach them how to find and play their favorite music on YouTube or just play a funny video on your computer and watch it together. In the sketch discuss the question “Why do conflicts between children and adults arise?”.
