Analytical report of opinion poll results

Students: Bulgaria-Greece-Portugal-Serbia

School year: 2020-2021

During the school year 2020-2021, a total of 36 classes teaching some 570 students were the target group of the piloting of the *YESI* Teachers' Toolkit in the partner countries. The schools that took part in the project were located in different locations in the countries. The students were between 6 and 12 years old, most of them being 8-11 years olds, with female students being slightly more than males at project level. The changes in students' attitudes and opinions are due to project implementation, of course, but in addition, they students have grown one year older between the two polls and more mature, and a year is a lot of time for a 7-8-9-10 year old with all the knowledge, skills and experiences gained during that time.

Greece: 8 classes; 146 students; age: 8-11; locations: Prefecture of Thessaloniki

Portugal: 8 classes; 165 students; age: 6-11; locations: Santarem, Entroncamento

Serbia: 5 classes;73 students; age: 7-11; locations: Dimitrovgrad

The questionnaire includes 12 questions which were answered prior to the implementation of the project at the beginning of the school year (Dec.2020 – Jan 2021), and then, once again at its completion (June 2021); its goal being to show the changes in students' attitudes and opinions between these two stages.

Students were asked to answer several questions related to basic human rights/children's rights (i.e. the right to education, the right not to work, etc.), diversity and social inclusion (i.e. questions related to new students originating from different cultures) and active citizenship (i.e. questions related on personal involvement).

Questions related to human rights - children's rights:

The majority of students believe that children need to be protected from harmful work. After completion of the activities, almost all students disagree with the possibility of a child to be working. Regarding their comments, most of the students strongly suggest that a child has the right to be educated – therefore needs to be in school rather than working. Their comments provide evidence that despite being very young, they have already learned that children's labor is illegal.

Freedom of thought and respect for children's views are rights which are related to Question 3 ("What will you do if your brother tells you that you are too young to decide whom to be friends with and whether to invite a friend home?"). The majority of students (44.7% in the initial poll versus 54.5% in the final poll) wants to ask their parents if they are allowed to invite home their friends. 23.5% in the initial poll versus 25% in the final poll responded that they will try to explain why they like their friend. 12.8% in the initial poll will agree with their brother – they think that they are too young to have their own opinion. However, only 5.6% stands for this idea at the final poll. 5.4% in the initial poll responded that they will do whatever they want to compared to 7% who responded like this in the final poll. The results could be explained with the fact that in Portugal the students who participated in the end-of-year poll were predominantly boys, and for a year they have developed a more independent personality. A small number of students (10.1% in the initial poll versus 3.7% in the final poll) do not know how to react. In general, the majority of students respect their parents' opinion and the rules that are established in their homes (i.e. asking their parents if they are allowed to invite a friend at home).

Question 10 includes 9 statements which refer to several human rights. Blue columns correspond to "Agree", orange columns correspond to "Disagree", whereas red ones correspond to "I don't know". Comparing the graphs on the initial and final poll, it is clear that most students support their initial responses, after the completion of the activities.

Describing the statements (from left to right), the majority of students agree that children need to visit a doctor when hurt, which corresponds to the right to health, water, food, environment. The second statement ("Children should be asked what they like") which describes the right of opinion also agrees with the majority or students' responses. Students disagree on the 3rd ("Kids don't know what they want") and 4th statements ("Children do not need know what their parents decide for them - for example, where to study, what sports to do, where to be treated if they are ill") - some students also do not seem to know how to respond towards these statements. Students strongly agree on the right to access education and their personal rights when being in the school (statements 5 and 6). The majority of students disagree on the 7th statement which describes that children do not have any rights at home – it is the parents who need to decide about everything. The majority of students agree on the 8th statement, whereas a significant number of students (101 responses in the initial poll compared to 47 responses on the final poll) do not know if they support the statement or not. The majority of students agree on the final statement which describes the freedom of expression ("Being able to say you disagree with something is very nice"), whereas some students do not know if it is fine to disagree with something.

Question 2 describes a boy named Ray, who came recently in the students' country with his family from Palestine and does not speak the local language. The blue columns correspond to "YES", the red columns correspond to "NO" and the orange columns represent the "I DON'T KNOW". The majority of students (87% of the responses in the initial poll versus 95% of the responses in the final poll), believe that they would become friends with Ray, whereas 9% of the students in the initial poll and 4% of students in the final poll do not know if they would become friends with him. Most of the students agree on their best friend's suggestion to invite Ray on his/her house; however some of them disagree with their friend's decision. To the question asking about their reaction in case Ray would refuse to eat the student's favourite meal, most of them (85% of the responses in the initial poll versus 96% in the final poll) would not be angry or feel uncomfortable.








When students were given photos of the newly enrolled children in their schools and were asked who they would like to meet first. In the initial poll the responses were distributed evenly with 8.5% answering that they cannot make their choice (nobody). At the final poll, the percentage of students who responded that they would like to meet Amalia and Abdul Azim first increased slightly: Amalia – 17% to 19.5%, and Abdul Azim – from 16% to 20.75%. This is not a big progress, but still, obviously students started understanding the difficulties a child faces when being in a foreign country and the support needed.

On question 7, students were asked who they would help to find friends. They could choose more than one answer, i.e. more than one new student. In the initial poll the majority responded that they would help Amalia and Abdul-Azim (60.5% and 50.8% respectively). Beatrice was also a good candidate for students' support in finding friends (32.6%), whereas Mark was probably thought to be a more confident person; therefore only 25.2% responded they would like to help him find new friends. 4.5% couldn't make their mind whom to help. At the final poll, priority was given again to Abdul-Azim and Amalia (53% and 59.3% respectively). Beatrice and Mark were also thought to be helped by their classmates to find friends (28.2% and 22.1% respectively), whereas 3.1% of the students did not know whom to help. In both polls – initial and final – there is a clear priority given to the students who seem to have come from non-European countries; therefore originating from different cultures. At this point it should be mentioned that since 2015 there are a lot of refugees, both students and adults, arriving from the Middle East and Africa in the Europe and the partner countries. Most students have seen refugee children in person and they are old enough to understand that they need to be helped to settle in the new environment.

When students were asked who they would invite home to a pajama party and the picture is quite different compared to the answers about helping the same 4 students to find friends. In the initial poll Mark and Beatrice are definitely the students' favourites for being invited to a pajama party with 30.5% and 27.2%, compared to 19.7% and 10.2% for Amalia and Abdul Azim. In the final poll, Mark and Beatrice still come first in the students' choice, but the percentage of students opting for inviting Amalia and Abdul Azim to this event has raised to





23.6% and 14.5% respectively. Another trend is that the number of students who have no opinion (answer "I don't know") has dropped down from 11.7% to 7.2%.

In question 9 students were asked who would be their choice NOT to seat with at the same desk. In both polls most of the respondents didn't indicate a specific student they wouldn't like to sit together with (53% in the initial poll versus 48% at the final poll). In the initial poll the remaining 47% were distributed among the four newly arrived students as follows – Amalia and Abdul Azim were rated by most students not to be desired as a companion to share a desk with (28.3% and 16.7%), whereas the percentage of students who wouldn't like to sit at the same desk with Mark and Beatrice were only 9.7% and 7%. At the final poll, the biggest change is in the change of opinion regarding Amalia with only 9.2% of students responding that they wouldn't like to share a desk with her. The students who answered they would dislike sitting together with Abdul Azim also dropped slightly in numbers.
